Important About the Power Plug When removing the power plug after turning off the machine, be sure to confirm that the POWER lamp is not lit. Using Specialty Media Canon recommends that you use Canon genuine media to ensure optimal print quality. Photo Quality Media Glossy Photo Paper. Note You cannot load paper other than A4, Letter, or B5 sized plain paper in the Front Feeder. Before you print, make sure that the paper source selection matches the paper source where you actually loaded paper. Press the Paper Feed Switch to change the paper source.
